Lessons Learned for Successful ESSER Purchasing

Spend now, not later.

The recent ESSER funding extension affords schools more time to make their purchasing decisions. However, it's best to act sooner than later instead of waiting until "back to school" this August to start organizing. Get a jump on using those remaining funds now. Allocations need to be submitted by September 2024 and spent by January 2025. So, prioritize your school's needs and goals now to maximize remaining funds in time.

Communicate investment value with everyone.

District leaders will want to make sure to share ESSER investment initiatives with the community as a matter of transparency. Schools will want to demonstrate the value of their investments. You can include a communication strategy within your ESSER plan that highlights how these investments will impact students and learning. This will encourage buy-in from everyone – including your school staff, district, and community. The success of your initiatives will depend on this key step to communicate ESSER fund usage.

Track results and student outcomes, not just expenses.

Results matter, especially when it comes to funding and student outcomes. Be mindful not to overlook the importance of demonstrating real results with your ESSER investments. Consider taking steps to be diligent about tracking progress toward your school's goals after you allocate and spend your funding. Show how your strategic investment improves learning and students' environment, whether you're investing in long-term strategies, displace/replace strategies, or general expense extensions.
